ORDINANCE NO. SP- 1904, S-2008

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE HONORABLE FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., CITY MAYOR, TO APPROPRIATE THE AMOUNT OF FOUR HUNDRED FOURTEEN THOUSAND PESOS (P414,000.00) OR SO MUCH THEREOF FOR THE FIRST QUEZON CITY INTERNATIONAL MARATHON TO BE HELD ON FEBRUARY 1, 2009, TO BE TAKEN FROM ANY AVAILABLE FUNDS OF THE CITY AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE EXECUTIVE RUNNERS CLUB PHILIPPINES, INC., FOR THE PURPOSE.

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government will sponsor the 1st Quezon City International Marathon to be held on February 1, 2009;

WHEREAS, the event will identify the City as a primary business site with a competitive advantage, rich history and a showcase of many interesting tourist sites including the most environmental friendly eco-park at the La Mesa Dam Reservoir;

WHEREAS, the said event will be funded by the Quezon City Government as host and will need to appropriate the necessary amount for the implementation thereof;

WHEREAS, Four Hundred Fourteen Thousand Pesos (P414,000.00) or so much is needed for the accreditation of Quezon City Government with the Philippine Amateur Track and Field Association (PATFA) and the Association of International Marathons and Distance Races (AIMS);

WHEREAS, the Executive Runners Club Philippines, Inc., (RUNNEX) has been designated as the Marathon Race Manager and will provide technical support for the 1st Quezon City International Marathon;

WHEREAS, RUNNEX is a non-stock and non-profit corporation duly organized under Philippine Laws and has been undertaking and managing running events throughout its twenty five (25) years of existence in line with its mission to promote running not only as a sport but as a way of healthy living;


WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government thru the City Mayor, needs to be authorized to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with the Executive Runners Club Philippines, Inc., for technical support and implementation of the 1st Quezon City International Marathon.

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. Appropriations – The City Mayor is hereby authorized to appropriate the amount of Four Hundred Fourteen Thousand Pesos (P414,000.00) for accreditation with the Philippine Amateur Track and Field Association (PATFA) and the Association of International Marathons and Distance Races for the hosting of the First Quezon City International Marathon.

SECTION 2. Memorandum of Agreement – The City Mayor and the Quezon City Tourism Council are hereby authorized to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with the Executive Runners Club Philippines, Inc., as Marathon Race Manager and shall provide technical support for the 1st Quezon City International Marathon.



SECTION 3. Effectivity - This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after its approval.
