**A ORDINANCE MAKING ROAD 8 FROM ROAD 3 TO ALLEY 3 AND ROAD 2, FROM ROAD 8 DOWN TO ALLEY 6 BARANGAY PROJECT 6, QUEZON CITY, A ONE-WAY STREET EVERY SUNDAY FROM 6:00 A.M. TO 9:00 P.M.**


NOW, THEREFORE,
