ORDINANCE NO. SP **1994** S-2010

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 39 (A) OF ORDINANCE NO. SP-91, S-93, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE "THE QUEZON CITY REVENUE CODE", AS AMENDED.

Introduced by Councilors ANTONIO E. INTON, JR., RAMON P. MEDALLA, BERNADETTE HERRERA-DY, RESTITUTO B. MALAÑGEN and JAIME F. BORRES.

Co-Introduced by Councilors Dorothy A. Delarmente, Allan Butch T. Francisco, Voltaire Godofredo L. Liban III, Franz S. Pumaren, Dante M. De Guzman, Diorella Maria G. Sotto, Edcel B. Lagman, Jr. and Vincent DG. Belmonte.

WHEREAS, the Congress of the Philippines enacted Republic Act No. 9640, otherwise known as "An Act Amending Section 140 (A) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 9640 reduces the maximum amusement tax rate imposable by province from thirty (30%) percent to ten (10%) percent of the gross receipts from admission fees;

WHEREAS, Section 151 of the Local Government Code grants the city the power to levy taxes, fees and charges which the province or municipality may impose.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. Section 39 (a) of the "Quezon City Revenue Code", as amended, is hereby amended to read as follow;



*“SECTION 39. Imposition of Tax for Amusement
Places and Amusement Activities.*


- a). *Amusement Places - There shall be collected from the proprietors, lessees, or operators of amusement places, a tax with the corresponding rate or percentage of the gross receipts from admission fees;*

<u>Amusement Place</u>	<u>Rate</u>
i.) <i>Movie Theater or Cinema</i>	<i>10% from the showing of foreign films</i>
	<i>0% from the showing of local films</i>
ii.) <i>Concert Hall, Comedy Bar, KTV Club, Cocktail Lounges and other Nights spots</i>	<i>10%</i>
iii.) <i>Carnivals, Theme Parks, Video and Game Arcades, Mechanical Rides and other Fun Houses</i>	<i>10%</i>
iv.) <i>Cockpits, Sports Stadia and Multi-Purpose Coliseums</i>	<i>10%</i>
v.) <i>All other Amusement Places not specifically falling under the above enumeration</i>	<i>10%</i>



SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.


