ORDINANCE NO. SP- **2025**, S-2010

*AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A ONE PESO (P1.00) INCREASE TO ADMISSION FEES IN ALL CINEMAS IN QUEZON CITY COVERING THE PERIOD FROM AUGUST 1 TO 31, 2010, THE PROCEEDS THEREOF TO BE DONATED TO THE BOY SCOUTS OF THE PHILIPPINES, QUEZON CITY COUNCIL, TO SUPPORT ITS NUMEROUS PROGRAMS AND ACTIVITIES.*

*WHEREAS, the Boy Scouts of the Philippines, Quezon City Council, a public corporation duly organized and existing pursuant to Commonwealth Act No. 111, as amended by Presidential Decree No. 460 and Republic Act No. 7278, is authorized to "x-x-x-x accept and receive funds, real and personal property, by gift, device, bequest or other means and to Conduct Fund Raising Activities x-x-x-x";*

*WHEREAS, for several years now, the said council, which is among the biggest, popular and renowned in the country, has been involved not only in promoting character development, providing adequate citizenship training and leadership among the Filipino Youth of the City, but inculcating in them love of country, civic consciousness and responsibility, courage and discipline and similar other virtues and moral values;*

*WHEREAS, prominent among the activities and services conducted by this Council are those which are geared towards the promotion of the moral, spiritual and physical well-being of the youth; the development of sports and livelihood and in assisting the promotion of the environment and waste management program and community development of the City Government, among many others;*

*WHEREAS, the BSP-Quezon City Council, which has approved various programs and projects to strengthen the boy scouting in the Philippines, will need the continued assistance of the City Government in the promotion and implementation thereof;*

*WHEREAS, moreover, this year is very significant to all Boy Scouts, particularly those belonging to the Quezon City Council, BSP, because of the scheduled 27<sup>th</sup> APR Jamboree and 3<sup>rd</sup> International Patrol Jamboree, on August 4-9, 2010, at Suncheon, Jeolla Province, South Korea, NCR/CLR KAB Olympics, on August 14-15, 2010 at Pasig City, Patrol/Crew Leaders Training Course, on September 17-19, 2010, Scouting Month Celebration on October, 1, 9, 16, and 23, 2010, 51<sup>st</sup> Annual Scout Executive Conference, on November 30, 2010, Christmas Camp 2010, on December 26-30, 2010. This council is expecting that some 5,000 scouts and scouters will participate in this momentous event;*

*WHEREAS, as a clear manifestation of its support to this Council, the City Government intends to increase the admission fees in all the city's cinemas by One Peso (P1.00), thereby, in the process, paving the way in the realization of the mission and vision of the boy scouting movement in Quezon City.*

**NOW, THEREFORE,**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:**

*SECTION 1. Admission fees in all cinemas/movie houses in Quezon City are hereby increased by One Peso (P1.00) from August 1 to 31, 2010.*


*SECTION 2. The proceeds derived therefrom shall be donated to the Boy Scouts of the Philippines, Quezon City Council, to help support and finance its program and activities.*

*SECTION 3. All concerned movie/cinema owners and operators are hereby authorized to transmit and turn-over to the BSP-Quezon City Council Scout Executive all sums of money collected who will account for all such money received and submit to the City Treasury of Quezon City, Official Receipts and such other pertinent records as maybe required in the acknowledgement thereof, subject to the usual accounting regulations. The City Treasurer is directed to submit the corresponding report to the City Council in connection therewith.*
