ORDINANCE NO. SP- 2034, S-2010

**AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A ONE PESO (P1.00) INCREASE TO ADMISSION FEES IN ALL CINEMAS IN QUEZON CITY COVERING THE PERIOD FROM FEBRUARY 1 TO 28, 2011, THE PROCEEDS THEREOF TO BE DONATED TO THE BOY SCOUTS OF THE PHILIPPINES, QUEZON CITY COUNCIL TO SUPPORT ITS NUMEROUS PROGRAMS AND ACTIVITIES.**


**WHEREAS, the Boy Scouts of the Philippines, Quezon City Council, a public corporation duly organized and existing pursuant to Commonwealth Act No. 111, as amended by Presidential Decree No. 460 and Republic Act No. 7278, is authorized to "x-x-x-x accept and receive funds, real and personal property by gift, device, bequest or other means and to conduct Fund Raising Activities x-x-x-x";**

*WHEREAS, for several years now, the said council, which is among the biggest, popular and renowned in the country, has been involved not only in promoting character development, providing adequate citizenship training and leadership among the Filipino youth of the City, but inculcating in them love of country, civic consciousness and responsibility, courage and discipline and similar other virtues and moral values;*

*WHEREAS, prominent among the activities and services conducted by this Council, are those which are geared towards the promotion of the moral, spiritual and physical well-being of the youth: the development of sports and livelihood and in assisting the promotion of the environment and waste management program and community development of the City Government, among many others;*

*WHEREAS, the BSP-Quezon City Council, which has approved various programs and projects to strengthen the boy scouting in the Philippines, will need the continued assistance of the City Government in the promotion and implementation thereof;*

*WHEREAS, this year is very significant to all Boy Scouts, particularly those belonging to the Quezon City Council, BSP, because of the scheduled Council Roundtable set on September 11, October 16, November 6, and December 4, all in 2010 in Quezon City; the Search for Outstanding Kab, Boy, and Senior Scouts on October 1, 8 and 25, 2010 in Quezon City; Council Kid/Kabsayahan on October 2, 2010 at Ateneo de Manila Grade School, in Quezon City; 2010 Scout Rally, Senior Scouts Tournament and Drum and Lyre Competition on October 23, 2010 at the Quezon Memorial Circle; the biennial Exchange Program activities with the Boy Scouts from Chiba City, Japan and our local Boy Scouts, consisting of historical visits to Corregidor, Mt. Samat and Subic Bay Freepot, including the Christmas Camp at Balara Filtration in Quezon City and related activities, from December 26, 2010 to January 2, 2011. Some 5,000 scouts and scouters are expected to attend and actively participate in these activities;*



*WHEREAS, as a clear manifestation of its support to this Council, the City Government intends to increase the admission fees in all the city's cinemas by One Peso (P1.00), thereby, in the process, paving the way in the realization of the mission and vision of the boy scouting movement in Quezon City.*

**NOW, THEREFORE,**


**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY  
IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:**

*SECTION 1. Admission fees in all cinemas/movie houses operating in Quezon City are hereby increased by one Peso (P1.00) from February 1 to 28, 2011.*

*SECTION 2. The proceeds derived therefrom shall be donated to the Boy Scouts of the Philippines, Quezon City Council, to help support and finance its various programs and activities.*


*SECTION 3. All concerned movie/cinema owners and operators are hereby authorized to transmit and turn-over to the BSP-Quezon City Council Scout Executive all sums of money received and submit to the City Treasurer of Quezon City official receipts and such other pertinent records as maybe required in the acknowledgement of the money received, subject to the usual accounting regulations. The City Treasurer is directed to submit the corresponding report to the City Council in connection therewith.*

*SECTION 4. Let the copy of this resolution be furnished the Quezon City Treasurer, the BSP-Quezon City Council Scout Executive and all cinema owners and operators operating or conducting business in Quezon City, for their information and proper guidance.*




**SECTION 5.** This Ordinance shall take effect on February 1, 2011.
