ORDINANCE NO. SP- 2111, S-2012

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET NO. 1 (GENERAL FUND BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2012) IN THE SUM OF SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY ONE MILLION PESOS (PHP751,000,000.00) TO FUND VARIOUS CITY INFRASTRUCTURE PROGRAMS AND OBLIGATIONS.

WHEREAS, as the emerging Philippine City of Asia, Quezon City needs to sustain its pre-eminence as a well-managed and planned metropolis with its immense infrastructure and urban development plans and programs;

WHEREAS, to spur its socio-economic growth, the infrastructure of Quezon City must cope with the changing times and its established vision and strategic development goals;

WHEREAS, the City Treasurer, Edgar T. Villanueva, on 13 January 2012, has certified that the surplus amount of Seven Hundred Fifty One Million Pesos (Php 751,000,000.00) is available for appropriation from the General Fund of Ten Billion Two Hundred Fifty Million Pesos (10,250,000,000.00) from Fiscal Year 2011;

WHEREAS, the surplus amount will enable the Quezon City Government, through the Bautista Administration, to cope with its contractual obligations, including approved public infrastructure and civil works investment projects.

NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. - There is hereby appropriated the amount of Seven Hundred Fifty One Million Pesos (Php 751,000,000.00), by way of this Supplemental Budget No. 1 to the 2012 General Fund Budget, to finance the development programs, projects and public infrastructure, including the Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses of the Quezon City Government.

SECTION 2. EXPENDITURE. - Expenditure of the amount of Seven Hundred Fifty One Million (Php 751,000,000.00) in accordance with specific items of expenditures is hereby broken down as follows:




SECTION 4. EFFECTIVITY. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
