ORDINANCE NO. SP- 2133, S-2011

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 1, 2, 3 AND 5 OF ORDINANCE NO. SP-1204, SERIES OF 2002 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE GRANTING BARANGAY LENGTH OF SERVICE BENEFITS/INCENTIVES TO ALL ELECTED OFFICIALS AFTER THEIR TENURE OF OFFICE.

WHEREAS, the Quezon City government acknowledges the vital role of the barangay officials as an instrument in the implementation and success of the government's enforcement agenda;

WHEREAS, compared to the other government employees in local government units, Barangay Officials are the lowest paid and least benefited in terms of government employment benefits and privileges;

WHEREAS, although, Barangay Officials are given some benefits provided under the Local Government Code of 1991, such benefits are apparently minimal compared to the overwhelming tasks they have to perform under existing laws, and as a general rule, they strive to do their job well, particularly in the area of peace and order and community relations, despite the limited resources made available to them;

WHEREAS, the Barangay Officials who have rendered service for three (3) consecutive terms are hereby given gratuity benefits in recognition of services rendered to the City in addition to what is provided for under the law.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY
IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. SP-1204, S-2002 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. All elected Barangay Officials who have completed three (3) consecutive terms by 2007 and thereafter are hereby bestowed a "Distinguished Public Service Award".

For purposes of giving the Award under this Ordinance, Barangay Officials shall refer to the Punong Barangay and Barangay Kagawad who has not been declared guilty of any administrative or criminal offense by any government agency, quasi-judicial bodies or courts of justice at any time during his/her term of office."

SECTION 2. Section 2 of Ordinance No. SP-1204, S-2002 is hereby amended to be read as follows: *A* *DS* *Y* *D*

"Section 2 Any elected Barangaay Official in all the City completing his/her term of office consecutively shall be given a "Distinguished Public Service Award" which shall consist of the following:

- a) A Plaque of Appreciation*
- b) A cash reward of Ninety Thousand Pesos (P90,000.00) for each three (3) term Punong Barangay and fifty thousand pesos (P50,000.00) for each three (3) term Barangay Kagawad.*

The "Distinguished Public Service Award" shall be bestowed by the City Mayor to the recipients based on the recommendation of the QC Barangay Operation Center (QC BOC) at an appropriate ceremony to be held for the purpose at the end of the three (3) consecutive terms."

SECTION 3. *Section 3 of said Ordinance is likewise hereby amended to read as follows:*

"Section 3. In cases where the highest ranking Barangay Kagawad shall succeed the position of Punong Barangay by virtue of operation of law under Title two, chapter 2 of the Local Government Code of 1991 on Vacancies and Succession, on his third (3rd) term as Barangay Kagawad, the latter shall receive the same cash reward as that given to Barangay Kagawads as hereinto mentioned."

SECTION 4. *Section 5 of Ordinance No. SP-1204, S-2002 is hereby amended to be read as follows:*

"Section 5. The sum of Five Million Pesos (P5,000,000.00) or so much thereof, as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated and be included in the 2012 Annual Budget of the Office of the City Mayor and the year subsequent to the immediately preceding Barangay Elections." X

SECTION 5. The QC Barangay Operations Centers (QC BOC) is hereby tasked to submit the list of the three (3) former barangay officials ending 2007 and thereafter to the Office of the City Mayor for the proper implementation of this Ordinance.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.


