ORDINANCE NO. SP- 2168, S-2012

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET NUMBER 2 GENERAL FUND BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2012 IN THE SUM OF SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTEEN MILLION SIX HUNDRED EIGHTY FOUR THOUSAND AND THIRTY FOUR PESOS (PHP715,684,034.00) TO FUND VARIOUS CITY INFRASTRUCTURE PROGRAMS.

WHEREAS, climate change and sudden weather disturbances has brought about unnecessary damage and destruction to various government infrastructure and buildings;

WHEREAS, the city government is mandated by law and its duty to put in place a mechanism to strengthen its resiliency to cope with natural and man-made calamities or disasters by providing the necessary facilities, installations and public infrastructure to obviate any further destruction of life and property;


WHEREAS, the City Treasurer, Edgar T. Villanueva, has certified that the surplus amount of Seven Hundred Fifteen Million Pesos (PhP715,000,000.00) is available for appropriation from the General Fund of Ten Billion Two Hundred Fifty Million Pesos (P10,250,000,000.00) from Fiscal Year 2011;

WHEREAS, the surplus amount will enable the Quezon City Government, to initiate the construction, rehabilitation or reconstruction of public infrastructure and civil works to address the needs of the 2.9 Million residents of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY
IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:


SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. There is hereby appropriated the amount of Seven Hundred Fifteen Million Six Hundred Eighty Four Thousand and Thirty Four (PhP715,684,034.00), Philippine Pesos by way of this Supplemental Budget Number 2 to the 2012 General Fund Budget, to finance the development programs, projects and public infrastructure projects of the Quezon City Government.



SECTION 4. EFFECTIVITY. This Ordinance shall be take effect immediately upon its approval.


