ORDINANCE NO. SP- 2216 \_\_\_\_\_, S-2013

**AN ORDINANCE APPROVING SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET NO 1, GENERAL FUND BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2013, IN THE SUM OF ONE BILLION PESOS (P1,000,000,000.00) TO FUND THE VARIOUS INFRASTRUCTURE PROGRAMS OF THE CITY AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS, Ordinance No. SP-2175, S-2012 approved the Annual Budget of the Quezon City Government in the total amount of Twelve Billion Three Thousand and Two Hundred Pesos (P12,000,003,200.00) to fund the expenditures of the City Government for Fiscal Year 2013;**

**WHEREAS, there is a need to appropriate a supplemental budget in the amount of One Billion Pesos (P1,000,000,000.00) to fund and complete various infrastructure programs and projects of the Quezon City Government;**

**WHEREAS, the local finance committee attests that the surplus amount of One Billion Pesos is available in the coffers of the Quezon City Government to support various public expenses;**

**WHEREAS, the said funds is sufficient to finance the construction of public infrastructure essential to address the needs of the residents of Quezon City.**

**NOW, THEREFORE,**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:**

**SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION – The amount of One Billion Pesos (P1,000,000,000.00) is hereby appropriated, as integral part of the General Fund Budget of the Quezon City Government for Fiscal Year 2013 by way of Supplemental Budget No. 1, to finance various infrastructure programs and expenditures of the Quezon City Government.**

**SECTION 2. EXPENDITURES – The appropriated amount of One Billion Pesos (P1,000,000,000.00) in accordance with specific items of expenditures is hereby broken down as follows:**



**SECTION 4. EFFECTIVITY** - This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.


