ORDINANCE NO. SP- 2323 S-2014

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING BENEFITS AND RECOGNITION TO CITY RESIDENTS REACHING THE AGE OF SEVENTY FIVE (75) YEARS OR MORE THIS OCTOBER, 2014 AS PART OF THIS YEAR'S 75TH FOUNDING ANNIVERSARY OF QUEZON CITY AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Section 4, Article XV of the 1987 Philippine Constitution mandates that "the family has the duty to care for its elderly members but the State may also do so through just programs of social security";


WHEREAS, the City Government unequivocally supports the said Constitutional provision and towards this end adopts policies that will protect the elder members of the society thereby ensuring their care and comfort;

WHEREAS, Section 458, paragraph (5) (xvii) of the "Local Government Code of 1991" provides that the Sangguniang Panlungsod shall approve ordinance which shall ensure the efficient and effective delivery of basic services and facilities x x x and in addition shall formulate policies and adopt measures mutually beneficial to the elderly and to the community; provide incentives for non-governmental agencies and entities and, subject to the availability of funds, appropriate funds to support programs and projects for the benefit of the elderly;

WHEREAS, the group of elderlies in our society stands as our pillar of strength, source of wisdom and inspiration, and our guardian of morality;

WHEREAS, a milestone achievement of this City, being in existence for the last seventy-five (75) years as the great former President Manuel L. Quezon once envisioned and dreamt of a "capital city that politically, shall be the seat of the national government; aesthetically the showplace of the nation"- this has been achieved and realized as Quezon City has, once, become the seat of the national government. Quezon City then became one of the most progressive cities in this country underscoring President Quezon's dream of being the showplace of the nation not just aesthetically but in all aspects;

WHEREAS, the City Government aims to show its appreciation to our elderlies, and values their importance and existence, thus, appropriate recognition and benefits should be accorded to them. y

NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. *The City Government shall provide benefits and recognition to City residents who will actually celebrate his 75th birthday this October 12, 2014 in conjunction with the city's 75th Diamond Celebration and those celebrating their 75th birthday this October, 2014 – herein referred to as "recipient diamond celebrant" and "recipient celebrant" respectively – and who must be duly registered at the Office of the Senior Citizens Affair (OSCA) of Quezon City for proper identification.*

SECTION 2. *The City Government shall grant the recipient diamond celebrant the amount of Seven Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P7,500.00) cash incentive and recipient celebrant Five Thousand Pesos (P5,000.00) after proper identification, documentation and submission of documents such as authenticated NSO copy of Certificate of Live Birth or certified true copy of Certificate of live Birth issued by the City Civil Registry of Quezon City, OSCA Identification Card or any valid government issued ID showing his/her residence and age.*

SECTION 3. *Both recipient diamond and recipient celebrants shall be formally recognized by the City Government by inviting and awarding his/her the necessary plaque or certificate of recognition during the Flag Ceremony or in any historical program of the City.*


SECTION 4. *The benefits and cash incentives provided for in this Ordinance shall be taken from the City's earmarked budget for the 75th Anniversary Foundation this 2014. y*





SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval.


