AN ORDINANCE APPROVING SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET NUMBER 2, GENERAL FUND BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2014 IN THE AMOUNT OF FOUR HUNDRED THIRTY EIGHT MILLION FOUR HUNDRED EIGHTY SEVEN THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED SIXTY PESOS (PHP438,487,860.00) TO FUND VARIOUS SOCIALIZED HOUSING PROGRAMS OF THE CITY AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, in order to provide affordable and decent human settlements for qualified Informal Settler Family beneficiaries, there are a total of Fifteen (15) In-City Socialized Housing Projects being undertaken by the City Government; y

**WHEREAS**, these socialized housing projects are intended to promote human and land tenurial security for qualified Informal Settler Family beneficiaries, subject to the payment of reasonable and affordable amortizations;

**SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION** - The amount of Four Hundred Thirty Eight Million Four Hundred Eighty Seven Thousand Eight Hundred Sixty Pesos (PhP438,487,860.00) is hereby appropriated and made an integral part of the General Fund of the Quezon City Government for Fiscal Year 2014 by way of Supplemental Budget No. 2, to finance the in-city socialized housing program of the city government.

**SECTION 2. EXPENDITURES** - The appropriated amount of Four Hundred Thirty Eight Million Four Hundred Eighty Seven Thousand Eight Hundred Sixty Pesos (PhP438,487,860.00) in accordance with the specific items of expenditures is hereby broken down as follows: X





**SECTION 4. REVIEW** - The Secretary to the Sangguniang Panlungsod is directed to provide a copy of Supplemental Budget No. 2 to the Department of Budget and Management, National Capital Region, for its immediate review and concurrence. A

**SECTION 5. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE** – If, for any reason, this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional by court of competent jurisdiction, other parts not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.
