ORDINANCE NO. SP- **2643** , S-2017

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING NEW ORLEANS STREET IN BARANGAY PINAGKAISAHAN, QUEZON CITY, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

WHEREAS, Section 458 (a) (5) (v) and (vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as "The Local Government Code of 1991", provides for the Powers, Duties, Functions of the Sangguniang Panlungsod:

"(v) Regulate the use of streets, avenues, alleys, sidewalks, bridges, parks and other public places and approve the construction, improvement, repair and maintenance of the same; x x x.

(vi) Regulate traffic on all streets and bridges; prohibit encroachments or obstacles thereon and, when necessary in the interest of public welfare, x x x.";

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Barangay of Barangay Pinagkaisahan passed Resolution No. 131, Series of 2016, entitled: y

"A Resolution Requesting the City Council to declare New Orleans Street as 'One side alternating Parking' from Denver Street to Ermin Garcia Street of Barangay Pinagkaisahan";

WHEREAS, the barangay experiences massive complaints due to double parking of vehicles on the aforementioned street, specially from the residents thereat and passing motorist;

WHEREAS, there is a need to implement a traffic scheme in New Orleans Street of Barangay Pinagkaisahan to restore order and discipline within the area;

WHEREAS, it is incumbent upon the City Government to regulate the traffic situation and road conditions within its jurisdiction.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. TITLE – This Ordinance shall be known and referred to as the **"TRAFFIC SCHEME IN NEW ORLEANS STREET, BARANGAY PINAGKAISAHAN"**

SECTION 2. REGULATION – New Orleans Street is hereby regulated with the following regulations:

- a. *One Side, Right side parking from Denver Street to Ermin Garcia Street every Monday, Wednesday and Friday at all time;*
- b. *One Side, Left side parking from Denver Street to Ermin Garcia Street every Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday at all time;*
- c. *Two side parking for light vehicle and for residents only during Sundays; ✓*



- d. For Establishment, heavy vehicle such as bulldozer, bus, container truck and the like for delivery is prohibited to stay for more than Ten (10) minutes, unless permitted by the Barangay;
- e. Parking on the said street is on a First-Come-First-Park basis only, no reserve parking for the purpose;
- f. Unserviceable/junk vehicle shall be towed or removed to maximize the parking space;
- g. The opposite side of the street as stated in items (a) and (b) shall be declared as a tow away zone, respectively;
- h. Parking/blocking the driveway is prohibited.


SECTION 3. ENFORCEMENT – This Ordinance shall be enforced and implemented by the Department of Public Order and Safety (DPOS) and by the Barangay Public Safety Officers (BPSO) of Barangay Pinagkaisahan.

SECTION 4. INSTALLATION OF SIGNAGE TRAFFIC SCHEME – The Department of Public Order and Safety (DPOS) and the Barangay Pinagkaisahan are hereby mandated to install Traffic Signage indicating that the street is regulated to inform motorists, drivers, vehicle owners and the public in general.

SECTION 5. PENALTIES – Any person or persons found violating the provision/s of this Ordinance shall be penalized in accordance with Appendix VI of Ordinance No. SP-1444, S-2004, also known as the Quezon City Traffic Management Code, as amended.

SECTION 6. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE – If, for any reason or reasons, any part or provision of this Code shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 7. REPEALING CLAUSE – All existing Ordinances and Resolutions, Local Executive Orders, Rules and Regulations inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed and/or modified accordingly. γ




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SECTION 8. EFFECTIVITY - This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.




