ORDINANCE NO. SP-**2717**, S-2018

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET NUMBER 1, GENERAL FUND FOR FISCAL YEAR 2018 IN THE AMOUNT OF FIVE BILLION ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY-THREE MILLION EIGHT HUNDRED EIGHTY-EIGHT THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY-EIGHT PESOS (PHP5,183,888,758.00) TO FUND VARIOUS MAINTENANCE AND OTHER OPERATING EXPENSES, PROPERTY, PLANT AND EQUIPMENT EXPENDITURES AND PROCUREMENT AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, on 22 December 2017, Ordinance No. SP-2640, Series of 2017 was approved providing the amount of Nineteen Billion Pesos (Php19,000,000.00) to cover for various expenditures to support the operations, programs, projects and activities of the City Government;

WHEREAS, upon the recommendation of the Finance Committee, duly certified by the Local Treasurer, that funds from surplus/ savings are actually available, there is a need to appropriate an additional amount of Five Billion One Hundred Eighty-Three Million Eight Hundred Eighty-Eight Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty-Eight Pesos (Php5,183,888,758.00) to fund various Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses, Property, Plant and Equipment Expenditures of the City Government;

WHEREAS, the Supplemental Appropriation shall be defrayed for various maintenance and other operating expenses and property, plant and equipment expenditures.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION – The amount of Five Billion One Hundred Eighty-Three Million Eight Hundred Eighty-Eight Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty-Eight Pesos (Php5,183,888,758.00) is hereby declared as Supplemental Budget Number 1 to be defrayed for the following purposes:

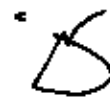

SECTION 2. AUTHORITY – The City Mayor is hereby authorized to disburse the funds appropriated under Section 1 hereof in accordance with the Project Procurement Management Plan for the purpose consistent with the provisions of Republic Act No. 9184 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations, as well as the provisions of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, particularly Section 455 (b)(1)(vi) which provides that “the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts, obligations and such other documents upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance.”

SECTION 3. REVIEW – Upon approval hereof, this Supplemental Appropriation shall be submitted to the Department of Budget and Management for Review and Concurrence.

SECTION 4. SEPARABILITY – If, for any reason, any section or provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, other sections, parts or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.

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SECTION 5. EFFECTIVITY - This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.

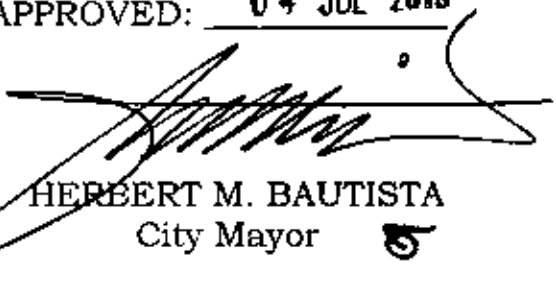
