ORDINANCE NO. SP 2740 S-2018

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A ONE PESO (P1/P1.00) INCREASE IN ADMISSION FEES IN ALL CINEMAS IN QUEZON CITY, COVERING THE PERIOD FROM NOVEMBER 1 TO 30, 2018, THE PROCEEDS THEREOF TO BE DONATED TO THE QUEZON CITY COUNCIL OF SECTORAL REPRESENTATIVES (QC-CSR), TO SUPPORT ITS NUMEROUS PROGRAMS AND ACTIVITIES.

WHEREAS, Section 34 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991" provides that local government units shall promote the establishment and operation of people's and non-governmental organizations to become partners in the pursuit of local autonomy;

WHEREAS, Section 35 of the same Code provides that local government units may enter into joint ventures and such other cooperative arrangements with people's and non-governmental organizations to engage in the delivery of certain basic services, capability-building and livelihood projects, and to develop local enterprises designed to improve productivity and income, diversify agricultural, spur rural industrialization, promote ecological balance, and enhance the economic and social well-being of the people; *

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Council of Sectoral Representatives (QC-CSR) has been established to comply with the mandates of the aforesaid provisions of the law and is more justified in its being part of the Quezon City Development Council, as its people's and non-governmental organizations' component;

WHEREAS, the QC-CSR has been active partners in the pursuit of local autonomy, and manifestly delivered its mission and vision;

WHEREAS, Section 36 of R.A. No. 7160 provides that a local government unit may, through its local chief executive and with the concurrence of the Sanggunian concerned, provide assistance, financial or otherwise, to such people's and non-governmental organizations for economic, socially-oriented, environmental or cultural projects to be implemented within its territorial jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, as a clear manifestation of its support to the Council, the City government intends to increase the admission fees in all city's cinemas by One Peso (Php 1.00), thereby, in the process, paving the way in the realization of its mission and vision.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. Admission fees in all cinemas/ movie houses operating in Quezon City are hereby increased by One Peso (Php 1.00) from November 1 to 30, 2018.

SECTION 2. The proceeds derived therefrom shall be donated to the Quezon City Council of Sectoral Representatives (QC-CSR) to help support and finance its various programs and activities.


SECTION 3. All concerned movie/cinema owners and operators are hereby authorized to transmit and turn-over to the Quezon City Council of Sectoral Representatives all sums of money collected, who will in turn account for all such money received and submit to the City Treasurer of Quezon City official receipts and such other pertinent records as may be required in the acknowledgment of the money received, subject to the usual accounting regulations. The City Treasurer is directed to submit the corresponding report to the City Council in connection therewith.



SECTION 4. Let the copy of this Ordinance be furnished the Quezon City Treasurer, the Quezon City Council of Sectoral Representatives and all cinema owners/operators operating or conducting business in Quezon City, for their information and proper guidance

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.




