ORDINANCE NO. SP- 2805, S-2019

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FIVE MILLION PESOS (PHP5,000,000.00) AS CASH REWARD TO ANYONE WHO WILL PROVIDE INFORMATION THAT WILL LEAD TO THE ARREST OF THE PERPETRATORS OF THE MURDER OF PUNONG BARANGAY CRISELL B. BELTRAN OF BARANGAY BAGONG SILANGAN, DISTRICT II, QUEZON CITY, TO BE TAKEN FROM ANY AVAILABLE FUNDS OF THE CITY, SUBJECT TO EXISTING ACCOUNTING AND AUDITING RULES AND PROCEDURES.

WHEREAS, Honorable Crisell B. Beltran is the incumbent Punong Barangay of Barangay Bagong Silangan, District II, Quezon City for three (3) consecutive terms from 2010 to present. She also served as Barangay Kagawad of the same Barangay from 2002 to 2007;

WHEREAS, on January 30, 2019, at around 11:45 a.m., while PB Crisell B. Beltran was traversing JP Rizal Street near Gate 3 of Filinvest II Subdivision, Barangay Bagong Silangan, she was ambushed together with her driver Mr. Melchor Salita by an unidentified motorcycle riding-in-tandem.

WHEREAS, based on initial investigation of PNP Police Station 6, Quezon City Police District (QCPD), there are four (4) unidentified male suspects on board two (2) motorcycles;

WHEREAS, by reason of the treacherous intent, PB Crisell B. Beltran and her driver died from assassin's bullets while there are four (4) other persons (3 minors and 1 adult) injured as a result of the dastardly act;

WHEREAS, the entire Quezon City Government strongly condemns this ruthless and senseless killings of innocent individuals.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SPECIAL SESSION ASSEMBLED:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION – There is hereby appropriated an amount of Five Million Pesos (Php5,000,000.00) to be taken from any available funds of the City, subject to existing auditing and accounting rules and procedures.

Section 2. PURPOSE – The amount appropriated therein shall be used for the sole purpose of giving cash reward to any individual who can give information for the immediate arrest of the perpetrators for the killing of PB Crisell B. Beltran and her driver Mr. Melchor Salita.

Section 3. SEPERABILITY CLAUSE – If for any reason, any section provision of this Ordinance is declared illegal or unconstitutional other sections or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.






