ORDINANCE NO. SP- **2827**, S-2019

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION NUMBER 1, GENERAL FUND FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019 IN THE AMOUNT OF THREE BILLION ONE HUNDRED TEN MILLION, FIVE HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE THOUSAND, FOUR HUNDRED FORTY-FOUR PESOS (PHP3,110,545,444.00) TO FUND VARIOUS MAINTENANCE AND OTHER OPERATING EXPENSES, PROPERTY, PLANT AND EQUIPMENT EXPENDITURES AND PROCUREMENT AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

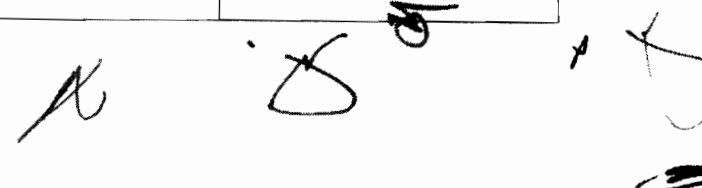

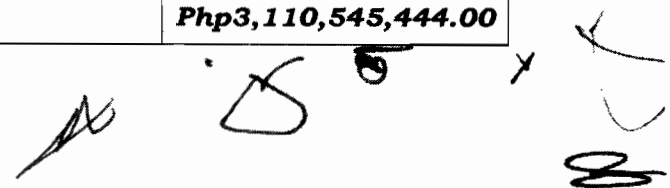
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

**SECTION 3. REVIEW** – Upon approval hereof, this Supplemental Appropriation shall be submitted to the Department of Budget and Management for Review and Concurrence.

**SECTION 4. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE** – If, for any reason, any section or provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, other sections, parts or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.

**SECTION 5. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE** – This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.

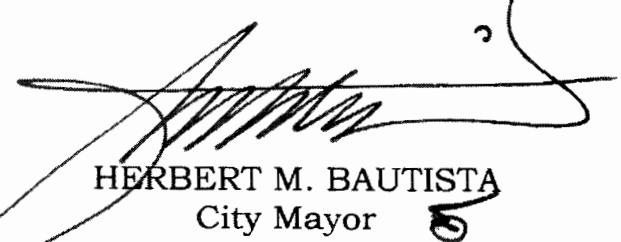
