ORDINANCE NO. SP- 2853, S-2019

AN ORDINANCE ALLOWING THE NEW TRAFFIC SCHEME OF BARANGAY SIKATUNA VILLAGE AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

WHEREAS, Section 458 (a)(5)(v) and (vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as "The Local Government Code of 1991", provides for the Powers, duties, Functions of the Sangguniang Panlungsod:

"(v) Regulate the use of streets, avenues, alleys, sidewalks, bridges, parks and other public places and approve the construction, improvement, repair and maintenance of the same, xxx."

"(vi) Regulate traffic on all streets and bridges; prohibit encroachment or obstacles thereon and, when necessary in the interest of public welfare, xxx."

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Barangay of Barangay Sikatuna Village passed Ordinance No. 03, S-2017, entitled:

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“An Ordinance making legal the new traffic scheme of Barangay Sikatuna Village, and providing penalties herein”;

WHEREAS, the Barangay experiences massive complaints due to the continuous problem of vehicular traffic on a daily basis;

WHEREAS, there is a need to implement a new traffic scheme for peace and order in the streets and the community, and for safety and protection of barangay personnel implementing the same;

WHEREAS, it is incumbent upon the City Government to regulate the traffic situation and road conditions within its jurisdiction.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. TITLE. – This Ordinance shall be known and referred to as the “New Traffic Scheme of Barangay Sikatuna Village.”

SECTION 2. COVERAGE. – All motorist, residents and non-residents, passing through the streets of this barangay are required to obey this new Barangay Traffic Scheme.

Section 2.4. NO PARKING. – 6 meters from the street corners – all streets

Section 2.5. NO ENTRY OF PUV in all streets

Section 2.6. NO ENTRY of Trucks/Buses in all Streets

SECTION 3. PENALTIES. – All penalties, fines or surcharges shall be the same as prescribed Under Ordinance No. SP-1444, Series of 2007 for motor vehicle violations.

SECTION 4. DEPUTATION. – Authorized personnel to implement this Ordinance are:


- a. The Punong Barangay
- b. Barangay Kagawad Chairperson on Peace and Order
- c. Barangay Public Safety Officer (BPSO)

Implementation shall be on a 24/7 basis unless there is a need to suspend in particular areas only for reasons of emergencies like fire, calamities, disasters and fiesta or special occasions.

SECTION 5. REPEALING CLAUSE. – All Barangay Ordinances relative to traffic management inconsistent with provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.


SECTION 6. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. – If only for any reason, any provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, other parts or provisions hereof shall continue to be in full force and effect.

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


SECTION 7. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. – This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval by the City Council and after posting of copies in the Barangay Hall and three (3) other conspicuous places in the Barangay.




