ORDINANCE NO. SP- 2859, S-2019

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF ORDINANCE NO. SP-2572, S-2017 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE BANNING THE TRUCKS AND OTHER HEAVY MOTOR VEHICLES FROM TRAVERSING THE STRETCH OF SAUYO ROAD AND OLD SAUYO ROAD IN BARANGAY SAUYO, QUEZON CITY FROM 6:00 A.M. TO 10:00 A.M. AND FROM 5:00 P.M. TO 10:00 P.M. IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE MODIFIED TRUCK BAN POLICY OF THE METROPOLITAN MANILA DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (MMDA)", AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, on February 13, 2017 the City Council enacted Ordinance No. SP-2572, S-2017 and the same was approved by the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista, on March 13, 2017;

WHEREAS, despite the passage of the said Ordinance which regulated the use of Sauyo Road and Old Sauyo Road in Barangay Sauyo, Quezon City, still, there is an occurrence of traffic congestion thereat due to its narrowness and the road stability thereof is gradually damaged;

WHEREAS, to ease the traffic congestion in the said roads and to maintain its stability and road-worthiness, there is an imperative need to make such roads free from wanton passage by trucks and other heavy motor vehicles;

WHEREAS, in a letter dated March 12, 2018 of the Metropolitan Manila Development Authority (MMDA), through its AGM for Operations, Asec. Roberto T. Almadin, the MMDA interposes no objection to the total truck ban in the said roads since the same are not included in their identified truck routes. A copy of the said letter is hereto attached and made an integral part hereof.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. SP-2572, S-2017 is hereby amended to read as follows:


"Section 1. Trucks and other heavy motor vehicles not owned by or unregistered in the name/s of the owner/business establishment located/operating along the stretch of Sauyo Road and Old Sauyo Road in Barangay Sauyo, Quezon City shall not be allowed to pass or traverse thereat at any time".

SECTION 2. A new Section 1-A shall be inserted after Section 1 of the same Ordinance to read as follows:


“Section 1-A. The owners or managers of all business establishments or warehouses located/operating along the stretch of the subject roads shall secure a ‘Pass Sticker’ for their trucks or heavy motor vehicles, which is valid for one (1) year, from the Office of the Punong Barangay of Barangay Sauyo, Quezon City to be pasted in the front windshield of the subject vehicles. The barangay concerned is hereby authorized to print the said sticker, either on their own or through a private entity, and to collect reasonable fee for the purpose in the amount not exceeding Two Hundred Pesos (Php200.00) which shall accrue to the general fund of the barangay.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.


