ORDINANCE NO. SP- 2867, S-2019

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING AN ANNIVERSARY BONUS TO ALL REGULAR EMPLOYEES OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF FIVE THOUSAND PESOS (PHP5,000) AND THREE THOUSAND PESOS (PHP3,000) TO ALL OTHER EMPLOYEES ON THE OCCASION OF THE CELEBRATION OF THE 80TH FOUNDATION DAY ANNIVERSARY OF QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, Quezon City was founded on October 12, 1939 under Commonwealth Act No. 502, as amended, and will be celebrating its 80th Year of Foundation on October 12, 2019;

WHEREAS, Administrative Order No. 316, S-1997 signed by then President, Fidel V. Ramos, states that:

“NOW, THEREFORE, I, FIDEL V. RAMOS, President of the Republic of the Philippines, by virtue of the power vested in me by law, do hereby order the extension of the grant of milestone Anniversary Bonus authorized under Administrative Order No. 263, dated March 28, 1996 to officials and employees in local government units, in accordance with rules and regulations to be issued for the purpose by the Department of Budget and Management. As defined under item 2.4 thereof, a milestone year refers to the 15th anniversary and to every fifth year thereafter.”

WHEREAS, it is fit and proper, that as we celebrate this milestone in our City, we acknowledge the hardworking people, our employees, regardless of status, who makes the wheel of service work for our constituents and our city, making Quezon City, a prime city;

WHEREAS, the grant of Anniversary Bonus on October 12, 2019, as authorized under existing laws, rules and regulations, showcases the gratitude of the Quezon City Government to its employees.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. An Anniversary Bonus is hereby granted to all regular employees in the amount of Five Thousand Pesos (Php5,000) and Three Thousand Pesos (Php3,000) to all other employees on the occasion of the celebration of the 80th Foundation Day of Quezon City.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated the amount of Fifty Million Pesos (Php50,000,000) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the purpose, out of the funds of the City Treasury, not otherwise appropriated for any other purpose.



SECTION 3. Pursuant to the Local Budget Circular No. 65, dated March 3, 1997, the Guidelines on the Grant of Anniversary Bonus in Local Government, the Barangays are hereby enjoined to grant anniversary bonus to their respective employees in celebration of the City's 80th Foundation Day Anniversary. Provided, that subject to availability of funds, payment of the Anniversary Bonus shall not exceed Php3,000 each employee. Provided further, that under Section 5.0 of the same Circular, the cost of implementing the benefit shall be sourced strictly from the respective funds of the local government units, subject to the budgetary limitations/requirements under R.A. No. 7160.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take upon its approval.


