ORDINANCE NO. SP- 2871, S-2019

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE BAGBAG INTEGRATED HIGH SCHOOL LOCATED AT BARANGAY BAGBAG, NOVALICHES, QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, Section 1, Article XIV of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that "the State shall protect and promote the right of all citizens to quality education at all levels and shall take appropriate steps to make such education accessible to all.";

WHEREAS, Section 17 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that local government units shall provide basic services and facilities including the establishment of school buildings;

WHEREAS, the Local School Board (LSB), through a resolution, recommends the establishment of an integrated high school in Barangay Bagbag, and name the same as Bagbag Integrated High School.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:


SECTION 1. There is hereby established under the Quezon City Schools Division Office an integrated public high school, located at Barangay Bagbag, to be known as the Bagbag Integrated High School.

SECTION 2. The supplemental funds necessary for the construction, maintenance, and operation of the said public school, as determined by the Local School Board, shall be taken from the Special Education Funds of Quezon City or from any available funds of the City.

SECTION 3. In case any provision of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid, the other provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
