ORDINANCE NO. SP- **2898** , S-2020

AN ORDINANCE FURTHER AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. SP-2273, S-2014, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE SEAL OF GOOD HOUSEKEEPING IN ALL BARANGAYS OF QUEZON CITY", AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. SP-2523, S-2016 AND ORDINANCE NO. SP-2588, S-2017.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. SP-2273, S-2014 entitled "An Ordinance Adopting the Seal of Good Housekeeping in all Barangays of Quezon City" was approved by the 19th Quezon City Council on 10 February 2019;

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. SP-2273, S-2014 was amended by Ordinance No. SP-2523, S-2016 and Ordinance No. SP-2588, S-2017;

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WHEREAS, the post evaluation of the Technical Working Group yielded some issues and concerns and recommendations for the implementation of the ordinance;

WHEREAS, there is a need to further amend Ordinance No. SP-2273, S-2014 in order to level the playing field and encourage the barangays to perform better;

WHEREAS, indicators for the awards must also be updated and amended to keep up with the changing needs and expectations of Quezon City.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. Section 1 Coverage of Ordinance No. SP-2273, S-2014 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 1. COVERAGE – All One Hundred Forty-Two (142) Barangays within the territorial jurisdiction of Quezon City categorized based on total income, as follows:

- a. Category A – all barangays with an income of Php40 million and above;**
- b. Category B – all barangays with an income of at least Php12 million but below Php40 million; and**
- c. Category C – all barangays with an income below Php12 million.**

SECTION 2. Section 2 (A) Gawad sa Huwarang Pamamahala Award of Ordinance No. SP-2273, S-2014 is hereby amended to read as follows:

b. Effective Governance

- 4. with at least 80% average rating in the Quezon City Road Obstruction Clearing Operations.**

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Section 2 (B) Dangal ng Lungsod Award of Ordinance No. SP-2273, S-2014 is hereby amended to read as follows:

b. Effective Governance

5. with at least 80% average rating in the Quezon City Road Obstruction Clearing Operations.

Section 2 (B) Dangal ng Lungsod Award of Ordinance No. SP-2273, S-2014, as amended by Ordinance No. SP-2588, S-2017 is hereby amended to read as follows:

d. Participatory Governance

1. Functionality of the mandatory Barangay Based Institutions: Barangay Peace and Order Committee (BPOC), Barangay Development Council (BDC), Barangay Anti-Drug Abuse Council (BADAC), Barangay Ecological Solid Waste Management Committee (BSWMC), Barangay Council for the Protection of Children (BCPC), Barangay GAD Focal Point System (BGFPS), Barangay Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (BDRRMC), Barangay Nutrition Council (BNC), Violence Against Women (VAW) Desk, Lupong Tagapamaya.

SECTION 3. Section 3 of Ordinance No. SP-2273, S-2014 pertaining to the Cash Award of Barangays with the Seal of Good Housekeeping is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 3. Barangays with the Seal of Good Housekeeping shall be entitled to a Cash Award, as a support fund to finance local development initiatives in furtherance of international (UN Sustainable Development Goals), national and local government goals and strategic thrusts."

SECTION 4. Section 4 Creation of Technical Working Group of Ordinance No. SP-2273, S-2014, as amended by Ordinance No. SP-2588, SP-2017 is hereby amended to read as follows:

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***SECTION 4. CREATION OF A TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP – There shall be a technical working group to be composed of the following:**

1. The City Mayor or his/her duly authorized representative;
2. The City Vice Mayor or his/her duly authorized representative;
3. City Council Secretary;
4. Head, Barangay and Community Relations Department;
5. City Budget Officer;
6. City Accountant;
7. DILG Quezon City Field Office Director;
8. Head, Environmental Protection and Waste Management Department (EPWMD);
9. Head, Quezon City Health Department;
10. Quezon City Disaster Risk Reduction Management Officer;
11. Executive Director of the Quezon City Anti-Drug Abuse Advisory Council; and
12. Head, Task Force on Road Obstruction Clearing Operations."

SECTION 5. Section 4 Hall of Fame Award of Ordinance No. SP-2588, S-2017 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 4. HALL OF FAME AWARD - Barangays who are conferred with the Dangal ng Lungsod Award for three (3) consecutive assessment years only shall be entitled to the Hall of Fame Award and a cash incentive in the amount of Five Million Pesos (Php5,000,000.00). Hall of Fame Awardees shall be exempted from qualifying for the award on the next assessment year.

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
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The incentive provided herein shall be used to fund the priority programs and projects of both national and local government thrust and priorities subject to the guidelines prescribed in the Implementing Rules and Regulations of this Ordinance.


SECTION 6. *This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.*
