ORDINANCE
CREATING AN ELECTRICAL DIVISION UNDER THE ENGINEERING
DEPARTMENT OF QUEZON CITY AND PROVIDING FOR ITS
PERSONNEL REQUIREMENTS, DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS AS WELL
AS APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY FUNDS THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Fire Department, with
the Electrical Division under it, was part of the City
Government until its integration with the PC-INP,
leaving the City Government without an office to
administer and enforce the Electrical Engineering Law
in Quezon City;

WHEREAS, under Republic Act No. 6975 otherwise
known as the "Department of Interior and Local Govern-
ment Act of 1990", the PC-INP was abolished and a
Bureau of Fire Protection was created among others,
"xxx responsible for the prevention and suppression
of all destructive fires . . . as well as the enforce-
ment of the Fire Code and other related laws xxx"
(Chapter IV, Sec. 54.);

WHEREAS, the Fire Code of the Philippines is
"primarily concerned with the proper maintenance,
safety and protection of buildings and structures
against fire" (MOA dated 01 August 1978);

WHEREAS, under Republic Act No. 7160 otherwise
known as "The Local Government Code of 1991", the
City Engineer shall "provide engineering services to
the local government unit concerned, including inves-
tigation and survey, engineering designs, feasibility
studies, and project management" (Sec. 477, par. b,
subpar. 4);
