ORDINANCE

AMENDING CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF ORDINANCE NO. SP-55, S-93, BY EXTENDING THE PERIOD OF AVAILMENT FOR TAX RELIEF FOR DELINQUENT REAL PROPERTIES IN QUEZON CITY UP TO SEPTEMBER 30, 1993.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. SP-55, S-93, which was principally introduced by Councilor Moises S. Samson, enacted by the Quezon City Council on February 18, 1993 and consequently approved by the Hon. City Mayor, Ismael A. Mathay, Jr., on February 24, 1993 granted relief to delinquent real property taxpayers of Quezon City with respect to interests and penalties on their real property tax subject to certain conditions;

WHEREAS, availment to the said tax relief was granted only up to June 30, 1993 as provided for under Section 4 of said Ordinance and its Implementing Rules and Regulations;

WHEREAS, since the implementation of said tax relief, a big number of delinquent real property taxpayers have already availed of the same, thereby generating a sizeable amount of additional revenues for the City Treasury but still off-mark the targeted tax delinquencies;

WHEREAS, a large number of delinquent real property taxpayers who unintentionally failed to avail
