ORDINANCE

GRANTING A MONTHLY FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE OF TWO THOUSAND PESOS (P2,000.00) TO EVERY BARANGAY TREASURER OF QUEZON CITY WITH FUNDS TO BE TAKEN FROM THE SPECIAL ASSISTANCE FUNDS OF THE CITY MAYOR EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 1993, OR FROM ANY AVAILABLE FUNDS OF THE CITY.

WHEREAS, under Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, it is so provided that "a more responsive and accountable local government structure instituted through a system of decentralization whereby Local Government Units shall be given more power, authority, responsibilities and resources;

WHEREAS, the basic political unit which is the Barangay can now impose and collect taxes, fees and charges subject to the limitations imposed in the Code and further collect other taxes and fees for the City;

WHEREAS, the task of collecting, keeping custody, disbursing and other matters relative to the position is done by the Barangay Treasurers;

WHEREAS, the monthly allowances being received by Barangay Treasurer ranges from Six Hundred Pesos (P600.00) minimum as provided for under Sec. 393 of
