AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. SP-117, S-93, BY GRANTING ADDITIONAL FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE IMMEDIATE FAMILY OF THE LATE SPO1 LORETO SISON WHO DIED A HERO'S DEATH IN THE ABORTED GL SUPERMARKET HOLD UP/ROBBERY.
