ORDINANCE NO. SP-166, 8-94

AN ORDINANCE ORDAINING THAT A PORTION OF BLOCK 5, PCS-57771, SITUATED IN BARANGAY VASRA, QUEZON CITY, CONSISTING OF TWO HUNDRED FORTY-SIX (246) SQUARE METERS BE SEGREGATED FROM SAID LOT AND BE MADE PART OF THE ALIENABLE AND DISPOSABLE PROPERTY OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT.

WHEREAS, a parcel of land, being a portion of Block 5, Pcs-57771, situated in Barangay Vasra, Quezon City, and consisting of Two Hundred Forty-Six (246) square meters had been lying idle without any use to the City Government;

WHEREAS, about twelve (12) years ago, the present tenant, Mr. Fidel Bondad, cleared the area and planted fruit trees thereat;

WHEREAS, said Mr. Bondad is willing to purchase the said portion of Block 5, Pcs-57771 from the City Government in availment of the City Government's policy of providing land to the landless;

WHEREAS, before the aforesaid lot could be disposed of, the same should first be segregated from its present title;
