ORDINANCE NO. SP- 188, S-94

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF, MORE OR LESS, THREE MILLION PESOS (P3,000,000.00) INITIALLY TO BE USED EXCLUSIVELY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF HISTORICAL MARKERS, IDENTIFYING LANDMARKS, AND SHRINES IN QUEZON CITY, IN SUPPORT TO THE CITY GOVERNMENT'S PROJECT, DUBBED AS "ANYO NG LUNGSOD QUEZON".
