ORDINANCE NO. SP-190, S-94

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3 OF ORDINANCE NO. SP-177, S-94, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS "AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE USE OF DESIGNATED CITY STREETS AND PROPERTIES AS TRICYCLE TERMINALS AND REQUIRING THE IMPOSITION OF TERMINAL FEES ON ALL TRICYCLE UNITS FRANCHISED IN QUEZON CITY".

WHEREAS, an Ordinance allowing tricycle units to use certain City properties upon payment of a fee was filed and approved by the City Council;

WHEREAS, Section 3 of said Ordinance prescribes that the fee shall amount to Three Hundred Sixty-Five Pesos (P365.00) annually;

WHEREAS, numerous requests have been sent by tricycle drivers and operators pleading that the amount of terminal fees be lowered;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

Section 3 of Ordinance No. SP-177, S-94 otherwise known as "An Ordinance Authorizing the Use of Designated City Streets And Properties as Tricycle Terminals And Requiring The Imposition Of Terminal Fees On All Tricycle Units Franchised In Quezon City" is hereby amended to read as follows:
