ORDINANCE NO. SP-197, S-94

AN ORDINANCE PERMANENTLY CLOSING ROAD LOT 80, AN ALLEY CONNECTING MAAMO STREET AND V. LUNA EXTENSION IN BARANGAY SIKATUNA, AND ALLOCATING A PORTION THEREOF AS SITE OF THE BARANGAY HALL OF BARANGAY SIKATUNA.

WHEREAS, Barangay Sikatuna has no Barangay Hall to serve its urgent need for an office, operation center and as venue for other barangay affairs and activities;

WHEREAS, Road Lot 80, (A City-owned Road Lot) an alley connecting Maamo Street and V. Luna Extension in Barangay Sikatuna is rarely used by either motor vehicles or pedestrians and would not cause any inconvenience to anybody if permanently closed, as evidenced by a certification signed by residents surrounding the road lot signifying that they interpose no objection to the planned conversion of the road lot into site for a barangay hall;

WHEREAS, the City Development Planning Officer has interpose no objection to the conversion of Road Lot 80 into a site for barangay hall;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sec. 21(a) of the Local Government Code of 1991, the local government unit may, pursuant to an ordinance, permanently or temporarily close or open any local road, alley, park or square falling within its jurisdiction;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. The City-owned Road Lot 80, an alley
