ORDINANCE NO. SP- 198, S-94

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF NINETY-SIX THOUSAND PESOS (P96,000.00), AT EIGHT THOUSAND PESOS A MONTH (P8,000.00) FROM JANUARY TO DECEMBER, 1994, BY WAY OF SPONSORSHIP SUPPORT TO MARICRIS FERNANDEZ A RESIDENT OF QUEZON CITY, WHO IS A LOCAL AND INTERNATIONAL JUNIOR TENNIS PLAYER AND IS NOW ON RIGID TRAINING PREPARATORY TO INTERNATIONAL JUNIOR TENNIS TOURNAMENT, CHARGEABLE AGAINST THE SPORTS DEVELOPMENT FUND OF THE CITY'S 1994 ANNUAL BUDGET.
