AN ORDINANCE RENAMING BO. IMELDA ELEMENTARY SCHOOL TO BETTY GO BELMONTE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL.

WHEREAS, Section 13, par. b (3) of the Local Government Code of 1992 authorizes the Sangguniang Panlungsod of highly urbanized cities to change the name of public elementary schools within its territorial jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, Bo. Imelda Elementary School in Bgy. Dona Imelda, District IV, Quezon City, was named after the donor of the parcel of land where the said school is now situated;

WHEREAS, BETTY GO-BELMONTE, before her untimely demise was a much admired civic minded journalist by profession and vocation, as well as a well-respected Educator-Mentor of schoolchildren;

WHEREAS, BETTY GO-BELMONTE, before her death, was known for her unselfishness and readiness to help the needy, most especially the victims of calamities;

WHEREAS, the residents as well as the Barangay Officials of Bgy. Dona Imelda have passed Resolution No. 16, S-94, urging the City Council to rename the Bo. Imelda Elementary School located at Bayani St., Bgy. Dona Imelda, Q. C. to Betty Go-Belmonte Elementary School;

WHEREAS, in order to extoll her name, virtue and accomplishments to our society, it is most befitting to use her name in a school where young schoolchildren can look up to her as their role-model;

WHEREAS, the favorable recommendation of the Quezon City School Board, required by Section 13 (e) of the Local Government Code have been complied with.
