ORDINANCE NO. SP- 531, S-97

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ITEM 3, PLANTILLA POSITION ON CO-TERMINUS STATUS, OFFICE OF THE VICE MAYOR, ORDINANCE NO. SP-481, S-96, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE ANNUAL CITY BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 1997, FROM LEGISLATIVE OFFICER TO LEGISLATIVE STAFF OFFICER VI AND PRESCRIBING THE QUALIFICATION STANDARDS THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, there is a plantilla position of a Legislative Officer (Salary Grade 24), with a co-terminus status under the Office of the Vice Mayor and duly funded in the Quezon City Annual Budget for Calendar Year 1997;

WHEREAS, an erroneous classification of this position was committed when it was originally created and approved in 1989 through a budget ordinance, likewise, providing for such plantilla position, and it was disapproved by the Civil Service Commission when the same was declared;

WHEREAS, subject position title is nowhere to be found under existing Civil Service Laws, Rules and Regulations and the Department of Budget and Management (DBM) Index of Occupational Services, Position Titles and Salary Grades (SG's);

WHEREAS, there is a need to amend Quezon City Ordinance No. SP-481, S-96, otherwise known as the Annual City Budget for Fiscal Year 1997, under the Office of the Vice Mayor, for the purpose of complying with existing Civil Service Laws, Rules and Regulations, particularly Sec. 2, par. 2.7, CSC Memorandum Circular No. 19, S-92, which provides, that:

“No change in designation or nomenclature of positions resulting in a promotion or demotion in rank or increase or decrease in compensation shall be allowed, except when the position is actually vacant, and the filling of such position shall be strictly made in accordance with Civil Service Laws, Rules and Regulations.”
