ORDINANCE NO. SP- 575 -S-97

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE FAMILY OF THE LATE SPO1 RODOLFO S. DAYAG OF THE TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT UNIT, CENTRAL POLICE DISTRICT COMMAND, (CPDC), QUEZON CITY, WHO DIED WHILE RESPONDING TO A REPORTED SIGHTING OF SUSPICIOUS LOOKING MEN AT KALAKASAN STREET, KARANGALAN VILLAGE, QUEZON CITY, ON APRIL 26, 1996, IN THE AMOUNT OF THIRTY THOUSAND PESOS (P30,000.00) TO BE TAKEN FROM THE APPROPRIATION OF THE CITY MAYOR'S OFFICE UNDER GRANTS, SUBSIDIES AND CONTRIBUTIONS IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR FY-1997.

WHEREAS, deceased Rodolfo S. Dayag served as a uniformed personnel with the rank of Senior Police Officer I at the Traffic Management Unit, Central Police District Command (CPDC), Quezon City, until the time of his death;

WHEREAS, on April 26, 1996, he was in the vicinity of Phase II, Kalakasan Street, Karangalan Village, Quezon City, together with PO3 Elpidio S. Bunagan of the Marikina Police Station, Eastern Police District Command (EPDC), Marikina City Metro Manila;

WHEREAS, on the same date, SPO1 Dayag and PO3 Bunagan were informed by a teener that two (2) unidentified fully armed men were wandering around the area under suspicious circumstances;

WHEREAS, the police officers responded immediately after they were directed to a dimly lighted spot where the armed men were seen;

WHEREAS, shortly thereafter, successive gunshots were heard and SPO1 Dayag together with PO3 Bunagan reappeared with bloody wounds which caused them to slump on the ground.
