ORDINANCE NO. SP-502-S-97

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE BY WAY OF ADDITIONAL RETIREMENT BENEFITS AS WELL AS FOR DEATH OR TOTAL DISABILITY BENEFIT TO MEMBERS OF THE BUREAU OF FIRE PROTECTION AND THE BUREAU OF JAIL MANAGEMENT AND PENOLOGY WITHIN QUEZON CITY AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS IN THE 1998 ANNUAL BUDGET AND EVERY YEAR THEREAFTER FOR THE PURPOSE.

WHEREAS, firefighter and jail guard officers perform vital and critical role and responsibility in the maintenance, protection, security and order of the citizens and prisoners' properties and belonging and in the discharge of their enormous task who have risk their lives at the great anxiety and sacrifices on the part of their families;

WHEREAS, due to financial constraints, it is rather unfortunate and a sad reality that the firemen and jail guards are not adequately and commensurately compensated for their services;

WHEREAS, in order to enhance the morale, efficiency and dedication to duty, improve the image of the firefighters and jail guards and at the same time serve as an incentive to these men for them to strive for excellence at all times, the Quezon City government deems it fitting and judiciously advisable to extend financial assistance to the members of the Bureau of Fire Protection and the Bureau of Jail Management and Penology;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:
