ORDINANCE NO SP-2867 S-2000

AN ORDINANCE ORDAINING AN ALTERNATING ONE-LANE PARKING POLICY ALONG CITY AND BARANGAY ROADS OF QUEZON CITY AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Section 458 (a) (5) (v and vi) of Republic Act 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, empowers the Sangguniang Panlungsod to "regulate the use of streets, avenues, alleys, sidewalks, bridges, parks and other places xxx; establish bus and vehicle stops and terminals or regulate the use of the same by privately-owned vehicles which serve the public; xxx regulate traffic on all streets and bridges; prohibit encroachments or obstacles thereon xxx;"

WHEREAS, the increased volume of vehicular traffic and the seemingly stunted and increasing breadth of the city's thoroughfares, streets, avenues, boulevards and alleys are further constricted by the wanton and undisciplined parking and/or stalling of vehicles along these roadways;

WHEREAS, there is a need to prescribe a systematized, organized and fully implementable mechanism of maximizing the limited roadspace available to ensure the smooth and unhampered flow of traffic:

WHEREAS, despite existing provisions for privately-owned and commercially-operated parking spaces, the motoring public still resort to parking vehicles wherever space is available regardless of its adverse effects on the flow of moving vehicular traffic:

NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. TITLE - This Ordinance shall be known as the "THE ALTERNATING ONE-LANE PARKING SYSTEM ORDINANCE OF QUEZON CITY."
