ORDINANCE NO. SP- 987 - 2001

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE DEADLINE FOR THE PAYMENT OF BUSINESS TAXES AND FEES FROM JANUARY 20, 2001 TO JANUARY 31, 2001

Introduced by Councilors GODOFREDO T. LIBAN II, EUFEMIO C. LAGUMBAY, ANTONIO L. SIOSON, VINCENT P. CRISOLOGO, ELIZABETH A. DELARMENTE, ROMMEL R. ABESAMIS, MA. FRESCA M. BIGLANG-AWA, MARCIANO P. MEDALLA, ERIC Z. MEDINA, JORGE L. BANAL, JULIAN M.L. COSETENG, NANEITE CASTELO DAZA AND BAYANIV. HIPOL.

WHEREAS, in view of the limitations of the existing manpower and facilities of the City Treasury to accommodate the large number of taxpayers paying their business taxes and fees for year 2001, the first quarter payment period from January 1 to 20 is deemed insufficient;

WHEREAS, in the interest of the tax-paying public of Quezon City, the deadline for payments should be extended to at least ten (10) days to accommodate their business tax payments without penalty;

WHEREAS, in consideration of the limitation of the present collection system to service the voluminous number of taxpayers, the City may provide for an extended grace period of time to accept payments without penalty, but, likewise, conform within the limits set by existing laws and ordinances;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. Coverage - All annual and quarterly business taxes and fees due and payable to the Quezon City government for 2001 which is due to be paid on or before January 20, 2001 can be paid not later than January 31, 2001, without any penalty, surcharge or interest;

SECTION 2. Penalty and Interest - All business taxes and fees due for the current period shall, however, be subject to a twenty-five percent (25%) penalty and monthly interest of two percent (2%) if not paid on or before January 31, 2001;
