ORDINANCE NO. SP- 1031, S-2001

AN ORDINANCE CONVERTING INTO RESIDENTIAL PURPOSE PART OF ROAD LOT 11 CONSISTING OF TWO THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED TWENTY-FIVE (2,625) SQUARE METERS COVERED BY TRANSFER CERTIFICATE OF TITLE NUMBERED 172926 ISSUED IN THE NAME OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT, SITUATED AT PUROK STO. NINO, CHESTNUT EXTENSION, WEST FAIRVIEW, BARANGAY FAIRVIEW, QUEZON CITY,

Introduced by Councilors GODOFREDO T. LIBAN II, WINSTON "Winnie" T. CASTELO, MA. FRESCA M. BIGLANG-AWA, MARCIANO P. MEDALLA, ENRICO S. SERRANO, ERIC Z. MEDINA and ALMARIO E. FRANCISCO.

WHEREAS, the Sto. Nino Homeowners Association had requested the Quezon City government that the parcels of land they are presently occupying be awarded and distributed to them at reasonable cost;

WHEREAS, the City Council approved an ordinance distributing the said parcels of land to present occupants/beneficiaries including part of Road Lot 11 consisting of two thousand six hundred twenty-five (2,625) square meters known as Chestnut Extension;

WHEREAS, there is a need to convert into residential purposes part of Road Lot 11 consisting of two thousand six hundred twenty-five (2,625) square meters considering that the same is part and parcel of the approved subdivision plan.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:


SECTION 1. There is hereby converted into residential purpose part of Road Lot 11 consisting of two thousand six hundred twenty-five (2,625) square meters covered by Transfer Certificate of Title Numbered 172926, issued in the name of the Quezon City government, situated at Purok Sto. Nino, Chestnut Extension, West Fairview Barangay Fairview, Quezon City.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
