AN ORDINANCE GRANTING FRANCHISE TO ES-EM PROPERTIES, INC., A JURIDICAL PERSON REPRESENTED HEREIN BY ITS PRESIDENT, MR. EDGARDO ESPINO, TO ESTABLISH, CONSTRUCT AND OPERATE A WET AND DRY MARKET AT ZABARTE ROAD, BARANGAY KALIGAYAHAN, QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, ES-EM Properties, Inc., represented by its President, Mr. Edgardo Espino, had applied for a locational clearance to construct and operate a wet market at Zabarte area, within the territorial jurisdiction of Barangay Kaligayahan;

WHEREAS, the clearance/permit applied for cannot be obtained unless a franchise is granted by the City Council, conformably with Section 458 (3) (vii) of the Local Government Code quoted as follows:

“Upon approval by a majority vote of all the members of the sangguniang panlungsod: grant a franchise to any person, partnership, corporation or cooperative to do business within the city; establish, construct, operate and maintain ferries, wharves, markets or slaughterhouse; or undertake such other activities within the city as may be allowed by existing laws: Provided, That cooperatives shall be given preference in the grant of such franchise.”

WHEREAS, the proposed site will cater easy access to market to an estimated thirty thousand (30,000) residents in the area;

WHEREAS, unless a franchise is given to the ES-EM Properties, Inc., the burden of the residents to an accessible market site will not ease, thus the imperativeness to grant the same;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. There is hereby granted a franchise to ES-EM Properties, Inc. to construct and operate a wet and dry market at Zabarte Road, Barangay Kaligayahan, Quezon City.
