ORDINANCE NO. SP. 1428 S-2004

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING PROVISIONAL AUTHORITY RENEWABLE EVERY YEAR TO PUROK PHASE 8 NORTH FAIRVIEW TRICYCLE OPERATORS AND DRIVERS ASSOCIATION, INC., (PHASE 8 TODA), TO OPERATE FITY (50) MOTORIZED TRICYCLES-FOR-HIRE TO PLY THE ROUTE FROM GATE AT ATHERTON STREET TO DRACHMA STREET UP TO CORNER MARK, PESETA, AND DOLLAR STREETS AND VICE VERSA, BARANGAY NORTH FAIRVIEW, DISTRICT II, THIS CITY.

Introduced by Councilor RESTITUTO B. MALANGEN.

WHEREAS, the Quezon City government considers the significance of an efficient and inexpensive transportation facility as a basic necessity which should always be made available to the riding public, particularly in the interior areas of the City that would bring them towards the main thoroughfares within the limits of its jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, the applicant is duly registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission with Company Registration No. A200203072;

WHEREAS, the Barangay Council of North Fairview has favorably endorsed the operation of Phase 8 TODA to service exclusively within the perimeter of Phase 8 Subdivision only through Resolution No. 61, S-2003;

WHEREAS, on October 10, 2003 at 9 A.M. an ocular inspection and verification has been conducted by the members of the Tricycle Franchising Board (TFB) and Transportation Regulation Unit (TRU), and on October 16, 2003, 2 P.M., a Special Board Meeting on the Tricycle Franchising Board (TFB) was held wherein the accreditation of Purok Phase 8 North Fairview Tricycle Operators and Drivers Association (Phase 8 TODA) was favorably recommended;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provision of Section 458 (3) (vi) of the Local Government Code, the City Council, by its inherent power, enacts ordinances granting franchises and authorizing the issuance of permits or licenses and regulating the operations of tricycles within the territorial jurisdictions of the City.
