ORDINANCE NO SP1 437, S-2004

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING TO ALL EMPLOYEES OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT AN ANNIVERSARY BONUS IN THE AMOUNT OF THREE THOUSAND PESOS (P3,000.00) ON THE OCCASION OF THE CELEBRATION OF THE 65TH FOUNDATION DAY ANNIVERSARY OF QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, the City government was founded on October 12, 1939, under Commonwealth Act No. 502, as amended, and will be celebrating its 65th Foundation Anniversary on October 12, 2004;

WHEREAS, Local Government Units are allowed to grant an Anniversary Bonus to its employees as provided under Administrative Order No. 316 of the Office of the President, and implemented through Local Budget Circular No. 65 dated March 3, 1997, which shall not exceed the amount of Three Thousand Pesos (P3,000.00);

WHEREAS, in his second State of the City Address delivered before the Quezon City Council on September 9, 2003, Honorable Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., Quezon City Mayor, took pride in reporting to the people that "our general fund last year reached more than P5.4 billion, exceeding for the first time in the recent 10-year financial history of Quezon City, the estimated budget", and that our "time deposit alone have reached P3 06 billion";
