ORDINANCE NO SP- 1449, S-2004

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING PROGRAMS FOR INSURANCE BENEFITS TO BARANGAY OFFICIALS AND BARANGAY SECURITY DEVELOPMENT OFFICERS (BSDOs) IN QUEZON CITY TO BE SHOULDERED BY THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF QUEZON CITY AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREOF.

WHEREAS, Barangay officials and duly appointed barangay security development officers may incur physical injuries and even death while performing their respective task of ensuring peace and order in their community;

WHEREAS, the Barangay officials and barangay security development officers are risking their lives for the sake of peace and order within their respective barangays, the City have nothing to give their families in return when something happens to them while they are in the performance of their duty;

WHEREAS, the pitiful plight of the barangay officials and duly appointed barangay security development officials are very well known and understood by the Sangguniang Barangays, the same is helpless to provide insurance coverage to the Barangay officials and due to meager resources;

WHEREAS, Section 393 (b) (2) and (d) of the Local Government Code of 1991 states that all Barangay officials and barangay security development officers, which shall number not more than twenty (20) in each barangay, shall be granted insurance or other benefits during their incumbency chargeable to the barangay or the city or municipal government to which the barangay belongs;
