ORDINANCE NO. SP. 1465 1 3-2004

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING ANY PERSON, NATURAL OR JURIDICAL, FROM RESERVING Α PORTION  $\mathbf{OF}$ STREETS, AVENUES, SIDEWALKS, ALLEYS AND PUBLIC OPEN SPACES FOR HIS/HER/ITS EXCLUSIVE USE OR AND PROVIDING PARKING SPACE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

WHEREAS, business establishments and private individuals are often times using the front or any available space within their place of business for personal use or reserved for their client;

WHEREAS, reserved exclusively "markings" are frequent if not always a cause of heated arguments among neighbors or pedestrians;

WHEREAS, Section 458 (5) of republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991" states that the Sangguniang Panlungsod shall adopt measures which shall ensure the efficient and effective delivery of the basic services and facilities as provided for under Section 17 of the Code, and in addition to said services and facilties, shall regulate the use of streets, avenues, sidewalks, alleys, and other public places.

## NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. Prohibiting any person, natural or juridical, from reserving a portion of public streets, avenue, sidewalks, alleys and other public open spaces for his/her/its exclusive use as parking space as well as prohibiting markings or signage reserved in any of the places mentioned.

SECTION 2. All traffic enforcers and all barangay officials in Quezon City are hereby deputized to strictly implement this Ordinance within their barangay, prohibiting the setting up of "Reserved or Exclusively" for parking sign or other signage similar or within the same purpose.

SECTION 3. The implementing rules and guidelines will be prepared by the Department of Public Order and Safety, the Office of the City Treasurer, the Central Police District and the Liga ng mga Barangay Officials.

SECTION 4. Violation of this Ordinance shall be punishable as follows:

First Offense

Fine of not less than Two Thousand

Pesos (P2,000.00)

Second Offense

Fine of not less than Three Thousand

Pesos (P3,000.00)

Third and Final Offense

Fine of not less than Five Thousand Pesos (P5,000.00), or imprisonment of not more than six (6) months or both at

the sound discretion of the court.

SECTION 5. Any provision or ordinance that are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed or amended.

SECTION 6. If for any reason or reasons, any part of this ordinance is held to be unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provision not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 7. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
