ORDINANCE NO. SP-**1466** S-2004

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE QUEZON CITY POVERTY ERADICATION COUNCIL, DEFINING ITS FUNCTIONS, OPERATIONS, MEMBERSHIP AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, it is the declared policy of the State to promote a just and dynamic social order that will ensure the prosperity and independence of the nation and free the people from poverty through policies that provide adequate social services, promote full employment, a rising standard of living and an improved quality of life for all;

WHEREAS, local government have the powers necessary, appropriate or incidental for its efficient and effective governance and those which are essential to the promotion of general welfare (Section 16 of the Local Government Code of 1991);

WHEREAS, in line with the thrust of the administration of President Gloria Macapagal-Arroyo on poverty reduction, the City Council should draw up a poverty reduction plans such as creating a Poverty Eradication Council in the City;

WHEREAS, the City need a Poverty Reduction Council that will enhance and sustain the programs and services formulated so that the level of poverty will be significantly reduced in the City.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. The Quezon City Poverty Eradication Council (QCPEC), hereinafter referred to as the Anti Poverty Council, is hereby created, the principal function of which is to formulate and propose programs, projects and activities designed and/or intended to eradicate, alleviate and reduce poverty incidence in Quezon City.
