ORDINANCE NO. SP- **1490**, S-2005

AN ORDINANCE CREATING TWENTY-SIX (26) ADDITIONAL PLANTILLA POSITIONS IN THE VETERINARY SERVICES DIVISION UNDER THE QUEZON CITY HEALTH DEPARTMENT, DEFINING ITS FUNCTIONS AND APPROPRIATING NECESSARY FUNDS THEREFOR TO BE TAKEN FROM THE FY-2006 ANNUAL BUDGET OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT.

WHEREAS, there is at present an insufficient number of local meat inspectors and veterinarians of the Veterinary Services Division under the Quezon City Health Department, tasked to monitor the operations and hygiene of the City's abattoirs and the prevention and control of animal communicable diseases;

WHEREAS, Chapter IV, Section 36 of the Sanitation Code of the Philippines provide, to wit;

"RESPONSIBILITY OF LOCAL GOVERNMENTS AND PRIVATE OPERATORS - Local governments and private operators in charge of public or private markets and abattoirs shall employ an adequate number of personnel to ensure their efficient operation and hygienic maintenance. These employees shall be under the direct supervision of the local health authority." (Underscore Supplied)
