AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 13 AND 20 OF ORDINANCE NO. SP-1264, S-2003 PROVIDING FOR THE REORGANIZATION OF THE PLANTILLA POSITIONS AND STAFFING PATTERN OF THE QUEZON CITY ANTI-DRUG ABUSE COUNCIL (QCADAC) AND THE QUEZON CITY DRUG TREATMENT AND REHABILITATION CENTER (TAHANAN) PROVIDING FUNDS THEREFOR AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. SP-1264, S-2003 was approved on 10 July 2003 to step up its campaign against the pernicious effects of narcotics and illegal drugs;

WHEREAS, the Ordinance also provided for a staffing pattern and qualification standard of employees to ensure the smooth operation of the Quezon City Anti-Drug Abuse Council and Drug Treatment and Rehabilitation Centre (TAHANAN);

WHEREAS, on 06 December 2004, the Department of Budget and Management (National Capital Region) has approved the proposed twenty-seven (27) and sixty-four (64) new positions for the Quezon City Anti-Drug Abuse Council and Drug Treatment and Rehabilitation Center (TAHANAN), respectively, pursuant to its authority under Administrative Order No. 42 and Republic Act 6758;

WHEREAS, there is a need to fine-tune these positions in order to provide the City government with competent and qualified employees.
