AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. SP-91, S-93, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE QUEZON CITY REVENUE CODE AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. SP 1452, S-04, SO AS TO REMOVE THE NUMBER 3 (a) PROVISION OF ARTICLE 30, SECTION 131 UNDER LETTER V THEREOF.

WHEREAS, it is the social responsibility of the City government to preserve and promote public health care and initiate pro-poor programs and policies.

WHEREAS, the number 3 (a) provision of Article 30, Section 131, under letter v of Ordinance No. SP-1452, S-2004, that amends Ordinance SP-91, S-93, more popularly known as the Quezon City Revenue Code, provides for a twenty Pesos (P20.00) payment for registration in clinical services rendered by the Quezon City Health Department;

WHEREAS, the business of government is service and not revenue generation;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Health Department is created primarily to provide basic health care services to the city's constituencies and should not focus its mission in generating income for the City government;
