ORDINANCE NO. SP- **1505**, S-2005

AN ORDINANCE MANDATING THE INSTALLATION OF BARANGAY VICINITY MAPS INDICATING THE BARANGAY BOUNDARIES, ROAD NETWORK, AND LAND MARKS TO BE SITUATED IN A CONSPICUOUS PLACE IN EVERY BARANGAYS OF QUEZON CITY, AND APPROPRIATING NECESSARY FUNDS THEREFOR, TO BE TAKEN FROM THE INFRASTRUCTURE FUND OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OR INCLUDE THE APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE SAME IN THE FY-2006 CITY'S ANNUAL BUDGET.

WHEREAS, it is the primary duty of the City Council to provide basic services that would protect, help and promote the welfare of its constituency by formulating measures that would truly address their needs;

WHEREAS, presently, almost all of the barangays in Quezon City have no barangay vicinity maps installed in their area wherein visitors and motorists can get an easy access to the barangay's complete territorial jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, the installation of barangay vicinity maps in conspicuous places along entrances of all barangays in Quezon City would truly help in promoting and ensuring safety and convenience both to the motorists and the visitors to easily find and locate their destination in every barangay;
