ORDINANCE NO. SP-1 5 10 S-2004

AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING ADDITIONAL GUIDELINES IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 6685, ENTITLED "AN ACT REQUIRING PRIVATE CONTRACTORS TO WHOM NATIONAL, PROVINCIAL, CITY AND MUNICIPAL PUBLIC WORKS PROJECTS HAVE BEEN AWARDED UNDER CONTRACT TO HIRE AT LEAST FIFTY PERCENT (50%) OF THE UNSKILLED AND AT LEAST THIRTY PERCENT (30%) OF THE SKILLED LABOR REQUIREMENTS TO BE TAKEN FROM THE AVAILABLE BONAFIDE RESIDENTS IN THE PROVINCE, MUNICIPALITY IN WHICH THE PROJECTS ARE TO BE UNDERTAKEN" AND PENALIZING VIOLATIONS THEREOF IN QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, it is a declared policy of the state to promote full employment and equality of employment opportunities for all;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 6685 requires private contractors, including sub-contractors to whom National, Provincial, City and Municipal Public Works Projects have been awarded to hire at least fifty percent (50%) of the unskilled and at least thirty percent (30%) of the skilled labor requirements to be taken from the available bonafide residents in the Province, City or Municipality in which the projects are to be undertaken, and penalizing those contractors who fail to do so;

WHEREAS, this enabling Act, which was passed by the House of Representatives on November 23, 1988 and on October 18, 1988 by the Senate was signed into law by the President on December 12, 1988 as one of those measures intended for the benefit of the Local Government and its constituents;
