ORDINANCE NO. SP- 1598, S-2005

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF THREE MILLION NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY-NINE THOUSAND AND TWO HUNDRED THIRTY PESOS (P3,989,230.00) FOR THE RENOVATION AND ADDITIONAL CONSTRUCTION OF THE GOVERNMENT AND NON-GOVERNMENT MULTI-PURPOSE HALL LOCATED AT BARANGAY STA. CRUZ, SAN FRANCISCO DEL MONTE, ROOSEVELT AVENUE, QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, a city resolution was passed by the City Council in 1994, favorably endorsed by the Barangay Council, authorizing the utilization of a property at Barangay Sta. Cruz, San Francisco Del Monte, Quezon City for the construction of the multi-purpose hall by the Quezon City government and non-government organizations;

WHEREAS, the initial construction of the said multi-purpose hall was done through the generosity of former Senator Freddie Webb and the late Congressman Reynaldo A. Calalay which allocated the amount of One Million Pesos (P1,000,000.00) and Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (P500,000.00) respectively, from their Countryside Development Fund;

WHEREAS, in the year 1998 a proposed Ordinance was filed in the City Council appropriating the amount of Two Million Pesos (P2,000,000.00) for the completion of the project but which only reached second reading and no further action was undertaken thereafter;
