ORDINANCE NO. SP- 1529, §-2005

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ALL CINEMA OWNERS AND OPERATORS TO INCREASE TICKET PRICES BY ONE PESO (P1.00) DURING THE ENTIRE MONTH OF SEPTEMBER 2005 FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUPPORTING THE SCOUTING PROGRAM OF THE QUEZON CITY GIRL SCOUT.
